PUBLICATION GUIDELINES

Enfoques is a scientific biannual review that corresponds with the scientific and academic criteria of the Argentine Center of Science and Technology Information (CAICYT), pertaining to the National Council of Scientific and Technical Researches (CONICET) of the Argentine Republic. *Enfoques* also integrates the Basic Nucleation of Argentina Scientific Reviews.

1. The articles have to be sent by e-mail to: direccioneditorial@uap.edu.ar, in Microsoft Word.
2. The articles sent for publication to *Enfoques*, must be unprecedented and it is assumed that each person that is the author has signed his/her conformity for the article to be published.
3. The language of the writing can be Spanish, English or Portuguese.
4. When the author send his/her article has to assure that it is original and that has not been postulated in another publication, other review or editorial house. For that reason, they will sent a complete form of "statement of originality" (see the web site of the review: www.uap.edu.ar/es/enfoques/).
5. The manuscripts of the articles are submitted to peer review by the members of the Scientific Board Advisor or other experts in the subject, depending on the specialty or orientation of the article. Since *Enfoques* is a double-blind peer reviewed journal which accepts high quality research articles, in which not only authors but the peer review are anonymous, the identity and other data of the author must be absent in the article. The data only has to appear in the first page of the article (the complete author name, institutional affiliation, title of the article, complete address, e-mail) and also a brief curriculum vitae that includes publications, academic degrees, profession and other relevant basic information (no more than 160 words). The author must assure that his/her name doesn't appear in other part of the article and that has been eliminated from the list of proprieties of the document.
6. The peer review results will be communicated to the author. They can be: (a) the acceptance of the article without modifications; (b) the acceptance of the article with minor revisions; (c) the acceptance of the article with mayor revisions; (e) the rejection of the article.
7. In case of disagreement between two peer reviewers, it will be solved by sending the article to a third one. The decision will be final and not subject to an appeal. This is an exclusive competence of the Editorial Committee of *Enfoques*.
8. The length of the articles must not be less than 4,000 words and should not exceed 9,000 words. It must be submitted on A-4 size pages, double-spaced and using 12-point type Times New Roman or similar font, numbered pages and margins not below 1 inch. Citations (less than four lines) will be included within the body of the text inside quotation marks. Block quotes (longer than 4 lines) will be included in single space, indented, and using a 10-point type font. Forum papers must not exceed 4,000 words and book reviews must not exceed 2,500 words. Words and phrases in bold type must be reduced to a minimum. Italic type must be used for foreign words. The Editorial Board reserves the right to consider the publication of manuscripts that exceed the previously mentioned limits.
9. Along with the manuscript, the authors must submit an abstract of up to 100 words and 5 keywords which will be used as topic descriptors, both in English, Spanish, and Portuguese.
10. Tables will be inserted in the main document. The data contained will be typed and without

special format. They will not be pasted as images.

11. The graphics, figures or images will be send as files of high resolution, in JPEG format. They have to be numbered as follows: image1, image2, and so on. In the text of the article (Word document) will be indicated in red the place where the image has to be incorporated: image 1, image 2, and so on, instead of placing the image.
12. The style of the journal is based on the Chicago Manual of Style, 14th Revised edition. Notes and references must be included in a footnote, with sequential numbering and 9-point type font, as follows:

13. Modifications or additions will not be allowed after the author has been notified that his/her paper was accepted for publication.
14. The journal is not obliged to return papers sent for publication.
15. The Editorial Committee of *Enfoques* reserves the right to publish the papers it may seems appropriate, in accordance with the editorial profile, its needs, and publishing possibilities.
16. The Editorial Committee of *Enfoques* reserves the final decision of the date of publishing the articles, according to the internal order of the journal.
17. The submission of the original copy implies the authorization for publication and online availability, without payment of copyright fees.
18. Each author will receive, free of charge, two copies of the journal and two offprints of the article. In case of being more than an author, they will received all together, the same number of copies and offprints.
